COST: Mandatory weekly family commitment of 1 hour per week of volunteerism.

HOURS: Monday - Friday from 8 am - 3 pm

DATES: June 18 - July 26, 2018 (No programming on July 4th)

GRADES: K - 7th grade. Must have completed grades Kindergarten through 7th grade.

***Must be a student/scholar currently enrolled in Osseo Area Schools.**
